

E-Waste Management Policy

The E-Waste management policy at Guru Nanak Dev Engineering College, Ludhiana is followed as per the guidelines of Punjab Pollution Control Board (PPCB) and E-Waste Management Rules 2016 and its subsequent amendments. The outdated E-Waste is collected and stored in isolated separate store.

The material is disposed-off to Collection Centers or Dismantlers or Recyclers authorized by Punjab Pollution Control Board at the end of financial year by following the quotation process. The record of E-Waste handled by the Institution is maintained as per Form - 2 of Punjab Pollution Control Board and Annual Return containing the details specified in Form - 3 of Punjab Pollution Control Board is submitted to Punjab Pollution Control Board. The various e-waste items disposed - off to authorized Collection Centers / Dismantlers / Recyclers are such as Computers, laptops, SMPS, Networking Components, printers, cartridges, monitors, UPS, Batteries, refrigerators, washing machines, air-conditioners, fluorescent and mercury lamps etc. After the collection of E-Waste material the Collection Centres / Dismantlers / Recyclers provides the Form – 6 i.e. E-Waste Manifest regarding the completion of process, for the records of Institution.
